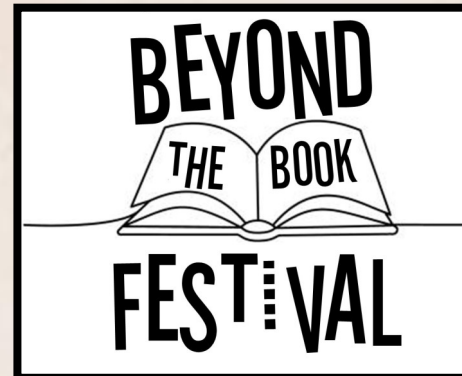

SUMMER READING

Books at the Big Top Summer Reading 2023 Round-Up

The Children's and Teen Summer Reading Program was held from Tuesday, June 5 through Saturday, July 15. Over the 6 week reading program children 11 and younger could read or listen to 10 books or for 5 hours and teens 12 years and older could read or listen to 5 books or 5 hours.

Of the 360 children and teens that registered, 210 completed their reading and received a prize plus the chance to win one of 5 different grand prizes.

Over 542 Children, Teens, and Families attended 19 children's school age, preschool, and toddler weekly programs and 2 teen programs in June and July. Kids made ice cream the old fashioned way with a crank and dry ice, and then got a yummy treat for their work! They also painted with squirt guns, had a camping day, practiced some circus skills, made and learned about popcorn, and played outdoor games. Preschoolers and toddlers had bubble days, learned about circus animals, and took trips fishing and to the beach through stories, songs, dance, activities, and fingerplays.

Over 300 Take and Create Craft Kits were given out to families to take home and make something together with most needed supplies right in the bag.

The Library also held their 2nd Annual Summer StoryWalk in the Library's Backyard and Little Woods featuring the book "Night Animals" by Gianna Marino.

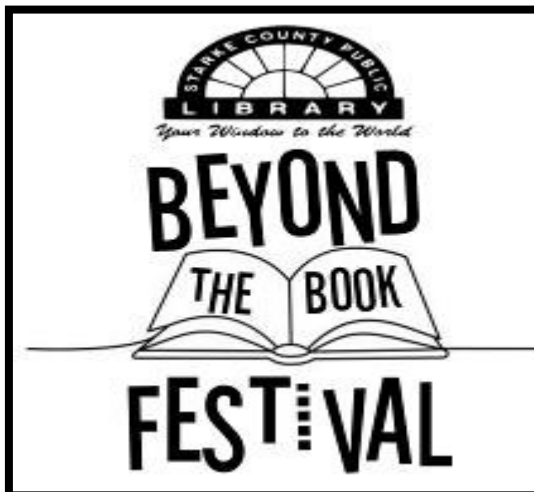
