Library of Seeds




- 15 vegetables, 3 flowers and 3 herbs (per person)





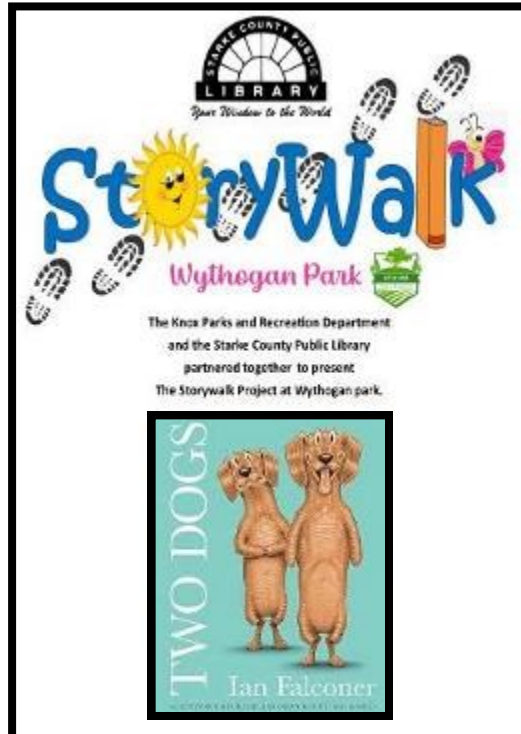
