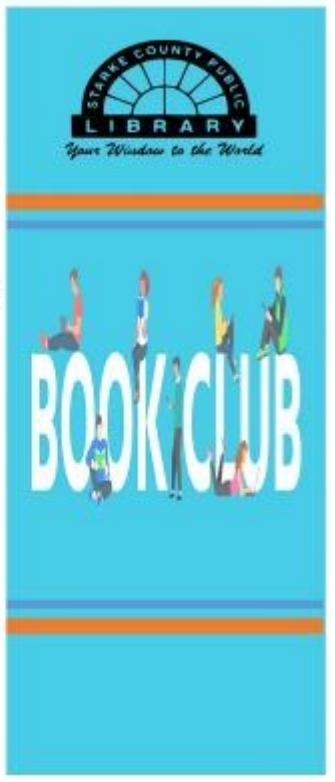



Prepare for fun and dress to get wet as we have a big blast before summer ends! Stay cool playing lots of water games and trying our giant slip and slide in the library backyard.








